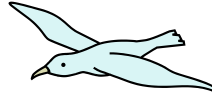

The purpose of a school discipline code is to communicate with students, parents, and teachers in order to maintain respect, pride, and responsibility throughout the school year.

Level I Infractions

- Cafeteria violations
- Classroom disruption
- Dress code violations
- Electronic device misuse
- No Student Agenda
- Public Displays of Affection
- Student-to-student inappropriate language
- Tardy to class
- Uncooperative – refusal to do work
- Unsafe behavior (minor level)

Teacher Interventions

- Verbally redirect
- Assign new seat/move seat
- Converse with student
- Contact parent
- Review student record
- Consult with other teachers
- Refer to guidance/social worker
- Conference with parent
- Assign time out
- Assign teacher detention
- Plan student/teacher mediation (with guidance)

Level II Consequences

Level II Infractions

- Bullying / verbal fighting
- Bus violations
- Cheating / plagiarism / forgery
- Computer violations
- Excessive tardiness
- Intimidation
- Misbehavior at Assembly / School function
- Non-compliance
- Peer aggression – non-physical (name calling / spreading rumors / insulting another)
- Playground violations
- Profanity
- Theft
- Unsafe behavior (kicking / shoving / poking)
- Vandalism

Consequences - 4/5

In Classes Only up to 3 days

2nd offense –

In Classes Only up to 5 days

Level III Infractions

- Assault
- Fighting / inciting / encouraging a fight
- Harassment
- Hazing / causing injurious behavior
- Insubordination / Defiance
- Leaving school grounds without permission
- Multiple office detentions
- Profanity directed at staff
- Violent threat

Consequences

1st offense -

3-day OSS

2nd offense -

5-day OSS and development of behavior plan

3rd offense -

7-day OSS with review of behavior plan

4th offense -

10-day OSS with referral to Superintendent for consideration of extended suspension and/or expulsion by the School Board

Suspension Information

*All suspensions require the student and parent to attend a re-entry meeting. The student is to present all homework completed while serving the out-of-school suspension.

Office Detention/ Suspension Information

Students are expected to have work for these two consequences.

Level IV Infractions

- Alcohol Use / paraphernalia
- Bomb threats / Fire alarm / Smoke bombs
- Drug Use / paraphernalia
- Physical contact with or aggression toward staff member
- Theft / Damaging School Property
- Tobacco Use / possession
- Weapon possession

In the case of Level IV Infractions (See Student Code of Conduct in Student Agenda for further information.), administration may suspend up to 10 days and/or recommend the expulsion of any student who violates any of these policies based upon the facts of each case and in accordance with applicable state and federal laws.

Lying that interferes with the discipline process may lead to more serious consequences.

Discipline consequences may be more severe than listed here based on the severity of the behavior.
