

SAFETY PROGRAM

It shall be the policy of the RSU 23 Board to take every reasonable precaution to protect the safety of all students, employees, visitors and others present in school buildings, on school grounds and at school-sponsored events.

A system-wide Safety Committee will be established to identify areas of concern and make recommendations for improving safety.

Each building administrator shall be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for his/her school, and the Superintendent shall have overall responsibility for the safety program of the school system. General areas of emphasis shall include, but not be limited to: in-service training, accident record keeping, plant inspection, driver and vehicle safety programs, fire prevention, school site selection, emergency procedures and traffic safety problems relevant to students, employees and the communities. The Superintendent will develop regulations to accompany this policy.
